### Ways to get involved with NSC matters

Most if not all NSC committees are open to the public and there is a right of **public participation** (refer to the NSC Constitution on website)- ask a question of the relevant Cabinet Member, Scrutiny Chair, or Chief Executive/ Director of Service.

Residents can submit a **Motion** or **Petition** to NSC which will have a right to debate or to be considered at the relevant committee depending on numbers.

**Contact the relevant Cabinet Member** directly by email (ideally addressed to just the one responsible so that they answer).

NSC **Complaints** and escalate to the relevant **Ombudsman**.

NSC **Citizens' Panels** and interest groups eg North Somerset climate and nature forum, **NS Together forum** etc.
